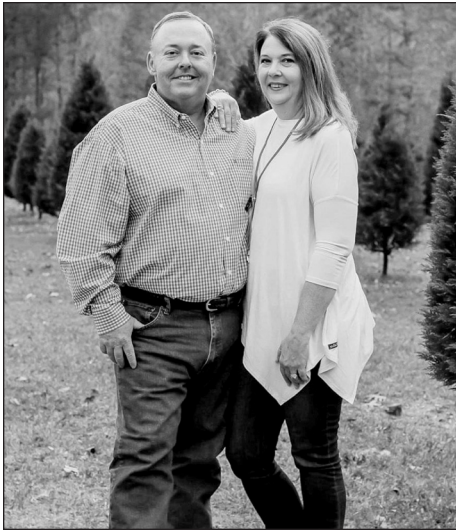


## CHAMBER HONORS

Mule Day is celebrated the 4th Saturday of September each year, so mark your calendars and we will see you again next year!
